FOUNDATION SEMINAR

Each first-year student at the University enrolls in a small, writing-intensive seminar of about 16 students in the fall semester. Foundation seminars (FOUN or RESC) are offered by many different faculty and focus on a wide variety of subjects. Whatever the topic, Foundation Seminars are designed to cultivate the attitudes, skills and knowledge necessary for students to benefit maximally from a Bucknell University education and to negotiate the complexities of the modern world.
